Explore the very best of British art on a tour with Stowe's Head, Dr Anthony Wallersteiner, at Tate Britain.

Dr Wallersteiner was a History Scholar at Trinity College Cambridge and completed his Doctorate in Art History and Theory at the University of Kent. He was shortlisted for the Daily Telegraph and Spectator Young Journalist of the Year Competition for a report on dissident writers in Eastern Europe. Anthony taught at Sherborne, St Paul's and Tonbridge and in 2003 was appointed Head of Stowe.

Discover much-loved favourites alongside new contemporary artworks, from the Pre-Raphaelites to David Hockney, Bridget Riley and Lubaina Himid. Tate Britain is also home to the world's largest collection of works by JMW Turner.

Following the tour, you are welcome to join us for lunch at The Cinnamon Club.
