

Day Places

Stage 1 - Enquiry

You have received a Prospectus and Registration Form from the School. Completion of the Form and payment of the Registration Fee indicates your interest in a place at Stowe. We will then invite you to attend our 2022 Day Open Evening. You may also want to attend our Year Six Taster Day.

Stage 2 - Private Visit & Interview

Between September 2019 and January 2020 you should book a Private Visit at Stowe. On this visit your child will be interviewed. Your son or daughter will also need to sit the ISEB Pre-Tests in October or November 2019.

Stage 3 - Offer of Place

Following the Private Visit and interview, the receipt of the ISEB Pre-Tests results and a reference from your child's current school, a decision will be made about whether to offer your child a place at Stowe. Conditional offers are made on the 31 January 2020.

Stage 4 - Acceptance of Place

On receipt of the completed Acceptance of Place Form and payment of the Acceptance Deposit, your child's place at Stowe is reserved, subject to meeting the entry requirements.

Key Dates for 2022 Entry

Families should Register their child at least three years prior to entry and prospective pupils must be Registered in order to be eligible to sit the ISEB Pre-Tests and book a Private Visit.
