SATURDAY EVENING

On Saturday evening, you are asked to arrive at 6.15pm and go directly to your House. Here you will be met by your Housemaster or Housemistress and their team. Parents are invited to stay for light refreshments whilst your child settles into their room and meets with the other members of the House. Parents depart at 6.45pm and the New Stoics will go to the State Dining Room for Dinner. After Dinner, the New Stoics will return to House for the evening. This first evening will provide new pupils with a good opportunity to familiarise themselves with their surroundings and to meet some of the current Stoics in their House. Please ensure you bring a sleeping bag and pillow.

SUNDAY MORNING ACTIVITIES

Sunday morning will be an opportunity for the New Stoics to get to know each other better.
